You are upgrading an application that was developed in Forms 6i. When you test the upgraded application, you notice that the boilerplate text labels overlap the text items (as shown in the exhibit). The labels appeared correctly when the application was Web-deployed with the Forms 6i Listener. What is a possible workaround for this problem?

- A. Use the WIDEN\_FIELDS=YES option when upgrading the application.


