2. Choose Layers > Smart Objects > Export Contents.
3. Choose the location for the file.
4. Enter your file name.
5. Click the Save button.

Answer option D is incorrect. The File > Save command is used to save a Photoshop document in a drive.

Answer option B is incorrect. The File > Export > Data Sets as files command is used to generate graphics using data sets.

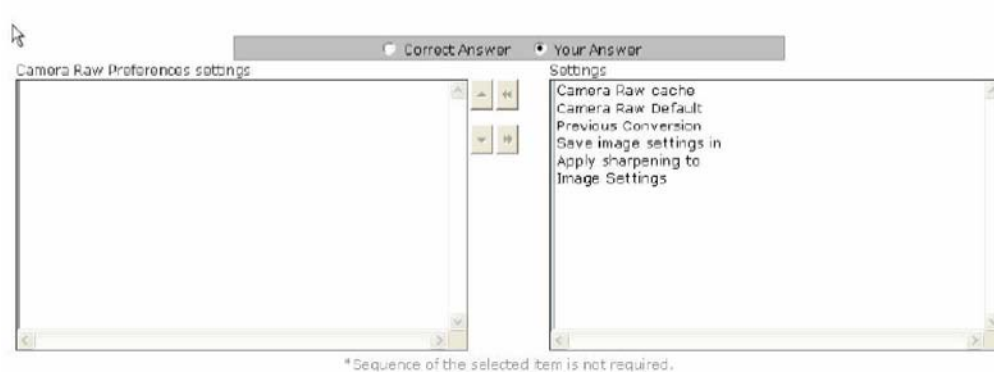
Answer option C is incorrect. The Edit > Convert to profile command is used to convert colors in a document to another profile.

This setting enables a user to decide whether to apply sharpening to the converted image or to the preview only.

Camera Raw cache.

This setting enables a user to choose the location and size of the Camera Raw cache, and allows him to purge the Camera Raw cache.

Answer option D is incorrect. This is not a valid option to accomplish the task.

The Behind mode allows you to add a color only to transparent pixels of a layer. It protects the colors that already exist on the layer and adds new colors to empty areas. This mode works only in layers with Lock Transparency deselected.

Answer option B is incorrect. Opacity determines to what degree the color, applied with the Brush tool, obscures or blends with the color beneath it. The color with 100% opacity is opaque and it completely blocks the color beneath it, whereas the color with 0% opacity appears transparent.

Answer option A is incorrect. Flow determines how rapidly paint is applied when you drag the Brush tool on the image. As you reduce the flow of the brush, the strokes become lighter.

Answer option C is incorrect. Hardness determines the size of the brush's hard center.

An Airbrush produces soft edged strokes. It is very much similar to spray painting. When you hold down the mouse button without moving the cursor, the foreground color builds up in the area around the brush. The effect of an Airbrush is greater when you drag the tool slower. The faster you drag it, the less effect it will have.

**QUESTION:** 136

You are creating a company's logo with a drop shadow for the company's Website. You want to maintain the full as well as variable transparency of the graphic and the shadow. In which of the following file formats will you save the image?

- A. JPEG
- B. GIF
- C. PNG-8
- D. PNG-24

**Answer:** D

**Explanation:**

The PNG-24 format supports hard-edged as well as variable transparency. It can preserve up to 256 levels of transparency in an image. The PNG-24 file format enables you to render the transparency without using matte color to fill transparent areas. This format is suitable for displaying continuous-tone images on the Web, but it produces larger files as compared to the JPEG format.

Answer option A is incorrect. The Joint Photographic Experts Group (JPEG) format does not support transparency. This format is suitable for displaying photographs and other continuous-tone images on the Web.

Answer option B is incorrect. The Graphics Interchange Format (GIF) format supports only hard-edged transparency. If the image has variable transparency, it renders the transparency, introducing a surrounding matte color. This format is suitable for displaying indexed-color graphics and images on the Web.

Answer option C is incorrect. The PNG-8 format is very much similar to the GIF format. It also supports hard-edged transparency.
