**QUESTION: 84**

Mike is going to publish and deploy his site on the World Wide Web. He has been told by senior developers that his Web site will take long to load on the user's computer, if the page weight of his Web site is very large. Which of the following methods can he use for reducing the page weight and increasing the loading speed of his Web site? Each correct answer represents a complete solution. Choose all that apply.

**Answer: D, C**

**Explanation:**

JavaScript and CSS, that are inline in HTML-based Web documents get downloaded each time a Web document is requested by the user. Using external files will result in faster loading of pages. JavaScript and CSS files are cached by the browser, as the size of the HTML document is reduced, without incrementing the number of HTTP requests. Browsers use a cache for reducing the number and size of HTTP requests, making Web pages load faster. By using a Cache control header, dynamic components can be made cacheable. This avoids unnecessary HTTP requests on subsequent page views.

**QUESTION: 85**

Mike has created a table using Visual Aids in Dreamweaver. The table contains columns having employee names and rows having information about those employees. Now he needs to divide the content of a particular cell in such a way that they can be presented in rows and columns. Which of the following is best suited to present Mike's content as required?

In Dreamweaver, Nested tables can be inserted into a cell of a table by simply clicking inside the particular cell, then Select Insert go to Table, set the Insert Table options, and click OK.

By using the Insert Row Span option, the area of a cell can be increased as the cell next to the selected cell gets included in it. Answer: C is incorrect. This action can be taken to determine whether to sort the column alphabetically or numerically. It can also be used to sort it in an ascending or descending order.

You are copying your files from the Local site to the Remote site. Which of the following are the activities that you can perform in the meanwhile?

**Explanation:**

You can create a new site while the copying process is running because it is a non server related process. The files at the Local site can be copied to the Remote site using the Put button. While the copying process is on, the operations that are not related to the Remote server can be performed. These operations are the background file transfer activities. The background file transfer activities are non-server-related activities that can run when the Get or Put function is running. Non-server-related activities consist of the general processes such as typing, editing external style sheets, generating site-wide reports, and creating new sites. While getting or putting files from the Files panel, activities such as putting, getting, checking in, checking

out files, undoing checking-out, creating a database connection, binding dynamic data, previewing live data cannot be performed.

Answer: C is incorrect. Checking Out files cannot be performed while the copying process is running. Check Out can be done using the Check Out button. The Check Out button is an important feature of the Files panel. In a collaborative environment where a number of people work with the components of a single website, 'check out' plays an important role in managing a site's files. When a user clicks the Check Out button, it indicates that the file that has been selected cannot be manipulated, as the file is being used or is being checked out by a user. The Check Out button is also used to put a file that did not previously exist on the remote site. Using the Check Out button, a user can check files out from the local and remote servers. When a file is checked out, the name of the user who checked out the file is displayed in the Files panel, along with a red check mark if a team member checked out the file. Answer: B is incorrect. Previewing Live data is a server related activity. Thus, it cannot be performed while the copying process is running. Live data includes Live code. Live code is the source code of a page that is displayed in the Live view. The code displayed in the Live view is the same source code that is displayed when the site is in a Web browser. Live Code view is dynamic and updates when interaction is done with the page in Live view. The Live code can be viewed by going to the Document bar and selecting Live Code. Answer: A is incorrect. Refreshing the Remote view will initialize all the files at the Remote server. Thus, it is a server related activity and cannot be done while the copying process is running.

**QUESTION: 87**

Mark works as a Site Engineer for ABC Inc. Mark has been assigned the task to make the Web page of the company's site heavy. Mark adds a number of links to other sites on the Web page. **Explanation:**

When the server is not able to be located, error 404 is returned. A broken link, also known as a dead link, is a link on the World Wide Web that points to a web page or server that is permanently unavailable. The most common result of a dead link or broken link is a 404 error, which indicates that the web server processed the instructions, but the specific page could not be found. In Dreamweaver, the Broken Links report in the Link Checker panel shows the listing of the links that point to files which are not present within the local site. Answer: B is incorrect. External links work fine if they are not broken. External links are links that connect to outside Web sites, pages, or files. Dreamweaver does not validate external links. Answer: D is incorrect. Orphan links are those links that are not connected to any other file or link in the whole Dreamweaver site. Answer: C is incorrect. Accessibility guidelines neither give an error nor make the server unavailable, if they are not validated for a Web site.

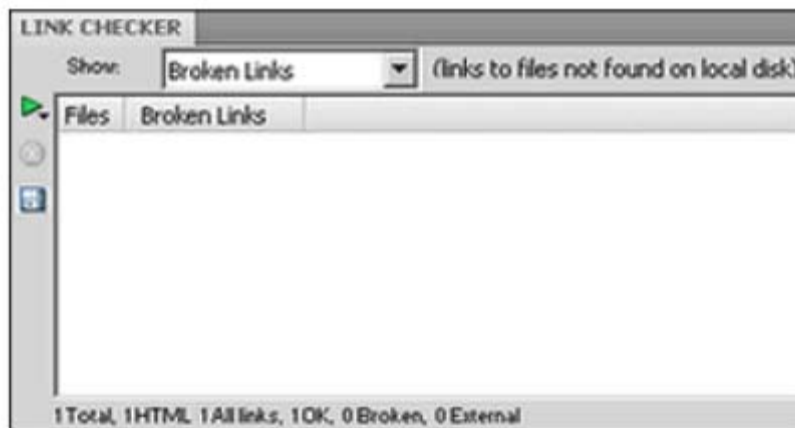
You have been assigned a project to locate and correct broken links of the Website of a company. Which of the following features of Dreamweaver will you use to complete your project?

The Link Checker panel is a feature in Dreamweaver that detects and fixes broken and orphan links. It is present in the Results panel group. A user can use the Show option drop down menu to choose among the external, orphan, and broken links. The Check Links button can be used to open a menu for checking links in the current, entire Local site, and the selected files in the site. The site report thus obtained can be saved using the Save Report option for later usage. The lower section of this panel shows the total number of detected and fixed links of each type.



Answer: B is incorrect. HTML Reports are the sets of information that are used for detecting the HTML code errors and bugs in a Web site. HTML Reports facilitate a user to compile and generate reports for several HTML attributes. The following table shows the HTML Reports types and their descriptions:

HTML Reports	Report Description
Missing Alt Text	It creates a report listing all the img tags that do not have alternate text. Alternate text appears in place of images for text-only browsers or for browsers that have been set to download images manually.
Checked Out By	It creates a report listing all documents checked out by a specific team member.
Accessibility	It creates a report detailing conflicts between your content and the Section 508 accessibility guidelines of the 1998 Rehabilitation Act.
Redundant Nested Tags	It creates a report detailing nested tags that should be cleaned up.
Removable Empty Tags	It creates a report detailing all empty tags that can be removed to clean up the HTML code.
Untitled Documents	It creates a report listing all the untitled documents found within the selected parameters.
Combinable Nested Font Tags	It creates a report listing all nested font tags that can be combined to clean up the code.

Display XML data in XSLT pages. Define URL parameters.

Define session variables.

Define application variables for ASP and ColdFusion. Define server variables.

Cache content sources. Copy a recordset from one page to another page. Make HTML attributes dynamic.

Answer: D is incorrect. The Server Behaviors panel is used to add Dreamweaver server behaviors to a page. It is also used to edit and create server behaviors.

The Server Behaviors panel facilitates performance of the following tasks:

It displays database records.

It defines sources of dynamic content.

It creates master and detail pages in one operation. It creates search and results pages.

It creates a record insert page.

It creates pages to update a record. It creates pages to delete a record.

It creates pages that only authorized users can access. It creates a registration page.

It creates a login page. It adds a stored procedure (ColdFusion). It deletes dynamic content.

It adds custom server behaviors.

Answer: B is incorrect. The Databases panel is used to create database connections, to inspect databases, and to insert database-related code in Web pages. Answer: C is incorrect. The Components panel is used to create and inspect components and to insert component code in Web pages.

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
